

My Equity Story








In the first image, it is assumed that everyone will benefit from the same supports. They are being treated equally.



In the second image, individuals are given different supports to make it possible for them to have equal access to the game. They are being treated equitably.



In the third image, all three can see the game without any supports or accommodations because the cause of the inequity was addressed. The systemic barrier has been removed.

Health Equity Task Force FAQs

The first-of-its-kind in Virginia state history and nationally to exist within an emergency response body, the nearly 100 member HEWG serves as a cabinet-level mechanism to apply a health equity lens to the Commonwealth of Virginia's COVID-19 response by:

 The VA COVID-19 equity task was built proactively -before the disparate impact of coronavirus on communities of color. VA uses an operational task force model.

 The VA Equity Task Force meets with all other major states and cities for real time learning and collaboration.

4. Create and sustain an organizational infrastructure to support accountability in achieving equity goals within the agency and Commonwealth





