




## Local Structure of CSA



## **FAPT Roles and Responsibilities**

- Review Referrals
- Determine Eligibility
- Assessment and Planning
- Develop the IFSP
- Monitor Services





## **Alternatives to FAPT**

#### **Multidisciplinary Team**

- SEC must approve in advance
- Must meet CSA membership requirements
- Must have policy





## **Placements Across Jurisdictional Lines**

- Prior to Placements
  - 1. Explore all appropriate community services
  - 2. Document that no appropriate placement is available within the locality
  - 3. Report the rationale for the placement decision to the CPMT






## Community Policy and Management Team (CPMT)










#### **CPMT**—Major Areas of Responsibility





#### **CPMT Responsibility: Planning & Policy Development**

- Develop local policy and procedures (i.e. referral process, accessing state pool of funds, etc.)
- Establish assessment of parental contribution (Parental Agreement)
- Establish contract process for services
- Create appeals process of FAPT decisions
- Manage process in securing CSA data






## CPMT Responsibility: Fiscal & Programmatic Management




- Establish accountability procedures for program and funds management
- Review, authorize, and monitor FAPT's funding recommendations
- Support family preservation through services and funds
- Employ utilization management process (CQI)
- Ensure use of appropriate funding sources (Medicaid, IV-E, PSSF, etc.)
- ✓ Serve as community liaison to OCS

#### **Important Takeaways of the CPMT**

Governs service provision to youth and families through local policy referrals

Serves as community liaison to OCS

Coordinates and plans for children's services in communities

Authorizes and monitors FAPT funding recommendations

Ensures quality assurance and accountability through utilization and fund management

Commits to deliver services that create positive outcomes





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
