Requirements for CPMTs:

Code Section 2.2-5206 (CPMT; Powers and Duties):

- "Coordinate long-range, community-wide planning that ensures the development of resources and services needed by children and families in its community including consultation on the development of a community-based system of services established under § 16.1-309.3;
- Review and analyze data in management reports provided by the Office of Children's Services in accordance with subdivision D 18 of § 2.2-2648 to help evaluate child and family outcomes and public and private provider performance in the provision of services to children and families through the Children's Services Act program..."



Role of Data & CQI in Long-Range Planning

- To monitor progress towards goals
- To identify areas of improvement
- To track trends

Review your locality's data and comparison data

 Bring data-informed activities, based on reviews, to CPMT


How well was it done? CQI Dashboard: Finance Menu

- Distinct Child Count & Net Expenditures (how much)
 - By "bucket": mandate type, service placement type, service name, and expenditure code
- How do child counts and average net expenditures change by each Type? Is this good/bad/neutral?

Is anyone getting better? CQI Dashboard: Outcomes Menu

- CANS submenu:
 - % of children showing improvement in three Domains
 - Five-year trend
 - State and Locality comparison
- How does your locality compare to state percentages?
- How has your locality trended over the last few years?



Is anyone getting better? Performance Measures Application & Report



- Seven indicators
- Three-year trend
- Up to five localities can be selected
- Updated annually


