CANVaS 2.0

There are now two versions of the Virginia CANS; the Standard CANS and the DSS-Enhanced CANS.

The Standard CANS will be used with children and youth and families, who receiving CSA-funded services and are case managed by the local court services unit, community services/board, behavioral health authority and the schools. The DSS-Enhanced CANS will be used with children, youth and families receiving CSA-funded foster care prevention services and all children in foster care and case managed by the local department of social services.

Much of the CANS assessment will be familiar to current users. The most significant changes are for:

- all users, the interface, navigation, ability to rate more than one caregiver and reports, and for
- DSS users, the addition of a required Trauma Module and a Child Welfare Module.
