WHY SHOULD YOU CARE ABOUT CSA HISTORY?

- Foundation for what you do every day.
- Gives meaning and purpose.
- Provides insight into what might otherwise seem random and unnecessarily complex.



WHY WAS CSA LAW PASSED?

- Study in 1991 of residential services due to exponential expenditure increases that could not be sustained into future.
 - 14,000 cases across four agencies yielded
 4,993 actual children in residential care.
 - Recognition of poor service planning and delivery for children and families.
 - Recognition of inefficiency in use of funds.



WHAT DID CSA LAW ACCOMPLISH?

- Provided mandate for cross-agency collaboration:
 - You want state money? Work together.
- Blended money:
 - Multiple agencies single appropriation.
- Established state's mission:
 - Child-centered, family-focused, communitybased services.
