Wrap-around Services for Students with Disabilities Funded Through the Comprehensive Services Act

January 2013

# **Report Mandate**

The 2012 Appropriation Act (Special Session I), Item 283 requires:

*M.* Out of this appropriation, the Director, Office of Comprehensive Services, shall allocate \$2,200,000 the first year and \$2,200,000 the second year from the general fund to localities for wrap-around services for students with disabilities as defined in the Comprehensive Services Act policy manual. The Secretary of Health and Human Resources shall issue a report detailing an assessment of the effectiveness of such services in placing or maintaining children in least restrictive settings. The report shall be provided to the Governor and the Chairmen of the Senate Finance and House Appropriations Committees no later than January 1, 2013.

# **Background**

The Code of Virginia, §2.2-5211 identifies youth who require funding under the Comprehensive Services Act (CSA) funding and includes in Section B.1:


"Children placed for purposes of special education in approved private school education programs, previously funded by the Department of Education through private tuition assistance;"

The State Executive Council (SEC) approved policy in 1996 which extended the above mandate to allow the provision of non-educational support services to students with disabilities when their needs extended beyond the school setting. Expenditures for such services are categorized as "Wrap-around Services to Students with Disabilities." This policy was clarified in 2011 to state:


"The special education mandate cited in §2.2-5211 B1 may be utilized to fund non-residential services in the home and community for a student with a disability when the needs associated with his/her disability extend beyond the school setting and threaten the student's ability to be maintained in the home, community, or school setting."

### **Effectiveness of Services**

The graph below illustrates the number of students provided "wrap-around services" under the extended mandate compared to the number of students served in "private day school" placements and those receiving education services in congregate care settings.



Analyses comparing communities utilizing wrap-around services to those not utilizing such services are illustrated in the two charts below.



It is notable that communities utilizing wrap-around services for students with disabilities have decreased the number of youth served in private day and congregate education programs for the past two years, while those not providing such services have increased the

number of youth served in these more restrictive placements. These data suggest that, though the impact is not large enough to reflect on statewide trends, the provision of wraparound services to youth positively impacts upon a community's ability to serve youth in lesser restrictive placements.

### Fiscal Year 2013

In accordance with the FY2012 Appropriation Act, the Office of Comprehensive Services allocated \$2,200,000 million to localities requesting funds to provide wrap-around services to students with disabilities. Sixty-nine localities requested and received allocations for wrap-around services. Attachment A lists allocations by locality.

Localities will be surveyed following the close of the second quarter of the program year, December 30, 2012, to determine their intent to fully utilize their allocations. With locality consent, allocations not projected to be utilized will be recouped and distributed to localities requesting new or increased allocations.
